

# TOOL LIST for CHECKERING CLASS

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\*\* This Tool List contains specific tools that will make learning to checker easier and not waste your money on items that are not useful. Please read through the list carefully as there are some options listed.

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## Tools:

- The following are Dem-Bart tools:
  - 1, 60 degree veiner (#241-026-060)
  - 1, #1 Fine (#241-100-001)
  - 1, #1 Course (#241-100-002)
  - 1, Handle (#241-010-000) \*Option = second handle
  - Checkering Gage (#241-000-001)
  
- The following are tools made by Gunline:
  - 1, #S-2 in 22 or 24 LPI
  - 1, #S-3 in 22 or 24 LPI (must match the LPI above)
  - 1, #PL-60F (#364-101-601)
  - 1, #PL-90M (364-101-902)
  - 1, #BCN Boarder-concave
  - 2, H-2 Handles (364-002-200) \*Option = 3 more handles
  
- Long Swing Arm work lamp
- Super sharp scribe (not carbide) You can make one out of 1/8" drill rod or stiff spring wire.
- Marks on Anything pencil (#347-125-600)
- Flexible plastic ruler
- Old soft tooth brush
- Gunline pin holder. See Midway -OR- 1/16" pin punch and hammer
- Optivisor in the appropriate magnification, if needed to see fine detail close-up.
- \*Optional: The school has several checkering cradles. If you want your own, I recommend the one from Brownells #080-026-000
- Optional: Carbide, Type 4, 75 degree, pull cut checkering tool from Ullman Precision (830) 627-9030

## Work Piece:

- Stock and/or flat block of wood (English walnut preferred) with pores filled. To checker.
