Strategic Planning

- 1. Present 2014 Athletic IPR (Information) Cheryl Aschenbach IPR was presented to the committee and it was suggested that the definition of retention should be included on the form for clarification.
- 2. Budget and Planning Process Overview (Information) Cheryl Aschenbach *The following Planning and Budget Development Process items were reviewed:*
 - a. Title 5 states that short term/long term goals, broad based input, and coordination with the educational planning process is required when financially planning.
 - b. We need an updated spreadsheet of Program Review recommendations upon Board acceptance annually.
 - i. Planning committees are responsible to identify gaps and needs in their area and develop a comprehensive piece
 - 1. It was suggested that feedback be provided on the priority lists regarding any denials to provide information back to the departments.
 - c. Development of the budget should be built with the Comprehensive Master Plan in mind
 - d. Referring to the Planning and Budget input process flow chart- the board makes decisions, Consultation makes recommendations
 - e. IPR and NIPR content is critical because that is how department requests get into the master plans

- h. Reminder that our responsibility on this committee and as campus leaders is to read all materials and look at those items with an institutional eye
- i. CIMP 2015-20, is what we are working from, but we are trying to include new items in this year's budget which creates confusion
- j. Same process applies to categorical or grant funded positions because it could impact the general fund at some point
- k. Departments need to do a better job of using the data in their IPR/NIPR to drive recommendations

3. Discuss IPR budget recommendation spreadsheet (Information) – Cheryl Aschenbach

The recalculation due to corrections in categoricals came to \$288,000. Still have approximately \$250,000 one-time funds available for next year.

ASB elections were held with a President and VP being selected. The VP declined the position but ASB will be move forward with scheduling activities.

12 employees attended the Student Success Conference this week and thought it was very informative. We have a lot of work to do with tying Equity/Student Success and Support/Basic Skills funds together better.
