Consultation Council

- Accept minutes from April 28th meeting (Consultation) Cheryl Aschenbach Accepted by consensus
- 2. Review of Board Agenda (Information) Dr. Hall
 There was some concern of the district taking a political stance regarding the
 State of Jefferson initiative.

Strategic Planning

- 1. Budget and planning process evaluation timeline (Information) Cheryl Aschenbach
 - Individual and Constituent and Planning Committee surveys were distributed this week. Must be completed by 5/17 and sent to Cheryl. Members were reminded of the survey deadline
- 2. Accept draft of Facilities Master Plan (Consultation)- Dave Suggested to combine items that appear multiple times (i.e. boilers). Explore the best solutions for the campus. Sometimes the solution may be expensive but in the end, more cost effective. The plan will return later for acceptance from the committee.
- Accept updated draft of Institutional Effectiveness Master Plan (Consultation) – Brian There is money to improve wider acceptance and participation in governance.

4. Accept draft of IT Master Plan (Consultation) – David
The issue of faculty computer refresh was raised. IT reports the computer
refresh has started. The oldest computers will be replaced first. It might be
nice for the faculty to have an idea when they might get a new computer. The
network may be an issue and the concern is being explored.

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- 5. Discuss IPR budget recommendation spreadsheet (Information) Cheryl Aschenbach
 - Staffing not included done in March
 Dave suggested to set aside \$100,000 for Dr. Armstrong to pay for the list
 of items she discovered on her walk around campus that need to be
 completed (i.e. paint walls, replace carpet, etc.). These funds were in
 addition to her \$60,000 contingency funds for instructional needs. It was
 proposed that all areas get some of these one-time funds to spend as they
 see fit. Concern was expressed that these list of items were not included
 in our budget process. It was stated that we need to follow our process
 for a number of reasons, accreditation being one of them. If we want to
 change it, we need to provide feedback in the surveys that are due to
 Cheryl. There was a suggestion to visit other campuses and explore what
 budget process they use.

Concern that we have not finished our budget process and the budget is due to the board. Dave suggested money not be spent until we can come to consensus.

A budget line item needs to include textbooks for inmates.
