KAI M. JONAS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:

\$600.00 award. This scholarship is awarded to a 2023-2024 graduating Lassen Community College student who is planning to transfer in the Fall 2024 semester to a four-year college or university. Must be majoring in one of the following areas: Kinesiology, Adaptive Physical Education, Criminology or Administration of Justice, Social Work, or Nursing. Must be an active volunteer in one of the following non-profit groups in Lassen County: Lassen College Special Athletes and Activities Club, Lassen County Special Olympics, Chamber of Commerce, American Cancer Society, American Red Cross, Lassen Family Services, Lassen Land Trails and Trust, Susanville Runners, Susanville Area Bicycle Association. Must have a 2.5 GPA or better. Please attach your unofficial transcripts to this application. Applicants will also be interviewed by the Special Athletes Activity Club (SAAC).

LASSEN COMMUNITY COLLEGE CSEA CHAPTER 591:

Two, \$200.00 awards available. Applicants must have attended Lassen College for at least two semesters and be enrolling full-time at Lassen College or transferring to another college or university for at least one more semester. Must have a 2.5 GPA or better.

DARLENE M. LUNDBERG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:

\$500.00 award. Applicant must be a woman resident of Lassen County for at least one year at time of application. Must have attended a Lassen County High School and achieved above average scholastic standing. Please state your address for the last year in your cover letter as well as the high school from which you graduated with your four year cumulative GPA (transcripts may be requested). Applications without this information may not be considered. Applicant must be currently attending a California college or university, as a sophomore, junior, with above average scholastic standing. Must demonstrate need for financial assistance by submitting their financial aid award letter, or by describing extenuating circumstances. Please submit a letter with the application describing your ability to meet the scholarship requirements.

JOHN MCCOLLUM MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:

\$1,000.00. This scholarship was given to Lassen College from the McCollum family in memory of their son, John Donald McCollum, who had been a 1941 Lassen High School Graduate. Senior McCollum served as Superintendent of the combination District of Lassen High School and Lassen Community College. The recipient of this scholarship is recognized at the Annual Commencement Ceremony. The recipient's name is engraved on a perpetual plaque displayed at Lassen Community College.

ROTARY CLUB OF SUSANVILLE & SUSANVILLE SUNRISE ROTARY CLUB:

\$1,000.00 award. For a Lassen Community College student transferring to a four year university or college in the fall.

SOROPTIMIST COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP:

\$1000.00 award. For students who are graduating sophomores from Lassen Community College and are continuing on to a four-year college or university to achieve a Bachelor's degree. Students with academic and personal honors will receive higher consideration. Student must now, in the past, or in the future plan to improve the lives of women and children, with their choice of education or a well-planned charitable endeavor. Please describe your future education and vocational plans in your statement of purpose. An additional In-Person Interview may be required.

T. STEVEN JACKSON J-CO TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP:

\$1,000 award. T. Steven Jackson was raised in Susanville and graduated from Lassen College before transferring to CSU, Chico where he earned his B.S. in Mathematics. He later continued his education and received his M.S. from the University of Nevada at Reno in Economics. T. Steven Jackson was not always a straight A student, however he was very successful in pursuing higher education and worked extremely hard towards achieving his degrees.

The T. Steven Jackson J-Co Transfer Scholarship is for the gritty, persevering, continually challenged, what some might call "under-dog" Community College Student that is looking to transfer to a 4-year institution to achieve their Bachelor's Degree. VOCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP:

\$300.00 award. This award is for a student who is enrolled in a course of study in a vocational field. Applicant must be returning to LCC in good standing, transferring to another college or university or graduating and entering the job market. Applicant must include at least one recommendation from a vocational instructor.

ROBERT IRVING SCHOLARSHIP:

\$400.00 Award. This scholarship is intended for high school students graduating from the Lassen Community College service area who will enroll in a course of study leading to an Associates Degree from Lassen Community College.

Candidates must:

- a) Hold an achievement of a 3.5 GPA from the previous three years of high school work with no letter grades lower than "C".
- b) Be enrolled in a minimum of 12 units (course number 01 to 99) for the semester of award at Lassen Community College or a 4 year College or University.
- c) Submit letters of recommendation from a minimum of two high school faculty members.
- d) Provide a statement of education and professional goals.

MONTICOLA CLUB – ETTA TARRY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

\$1,000 award. Transfer student from LCC continuing to a 4 year during the next school year. 3.0 GPA required. Application to include autobiography, official college transcripts & counselor or dean's report to accompany application.
