

## DESCRIPTION

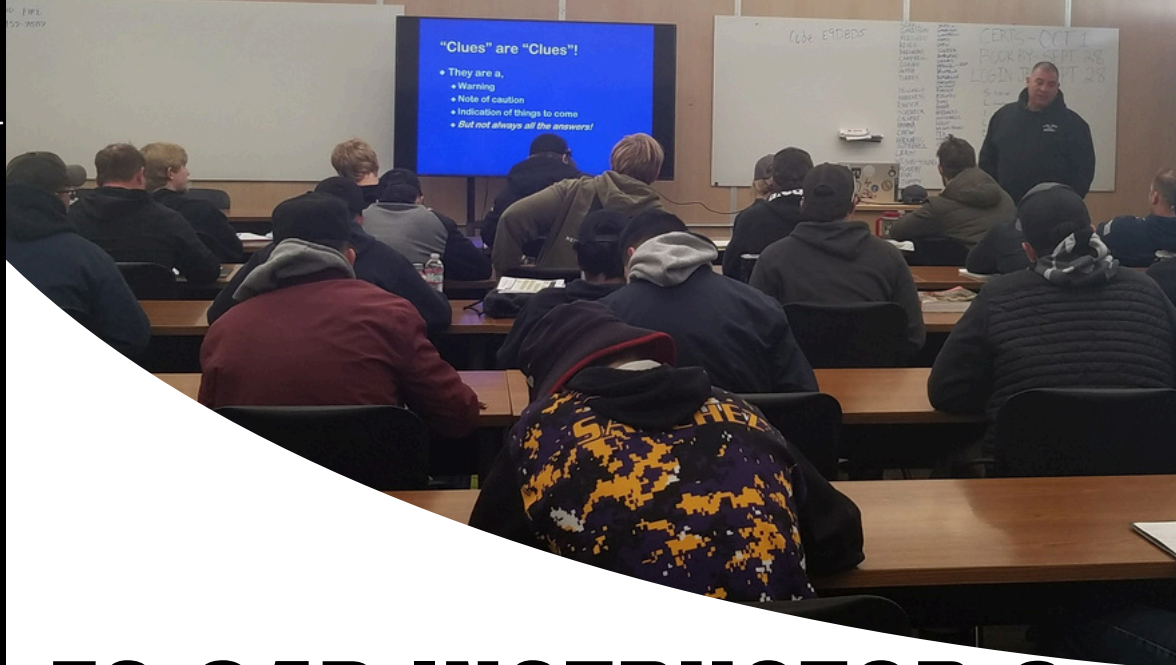
