FS 60.1 Recommended Preparation prior to enrollment includes: California FF1 Modules 1C: Willdland and 1B: Hazardous Materials or equivalent

NOTE: An additional cost may be incurred by the student for PPE Turnout rentals to meet the safety requirements for the Live fire components of the class. (approx. \$400-\$650/semester)
