

DESCRIPTION

This course trains personnel in advanced Incident Command System (ICS) concepts, building on ICS 100 and 200. It is intended for those assuming supervisory roles in incidents.

Modules include:

- Unified Command
- Incident/Event Assessment & Agency Guidance
- Incident Resource Management Planning
- Demobilization
- Transfer of Command & Close-Out

Prerequisites: FEMA ICS 100, ICS-200, IS-700 and IS-800 or equivalent.
