

## DESCRIPTION

This course is designed to equip emergency responders with the essential skills needed for the safe extrication of victims from passenger vehicles, in compliance with AHK policies. Participants will receive instruction on critical topics including incident assessment, action plan development, safety zone establishment, hazard mitigation strategies, and specialized rescue techniques for vehicles in varying orientations. The training encompasses awareness, operational, and technician levels as outlined in NFPA 1006 (2021).

A fee of \$81.00 for SFT will be collected at the time of enrollment.

PPE: Full Structural Turnouts required. Students are encouraged to bring their own, or LCC can provide temporary turnouts for the class dates.
