DESCRIPTION

This course offers a comprehensive introduction to the operation, maintenance, and effective use of internal combustion engine-powered chainsaws, with a specific focus on their application in tactical wildland firefighting. Participants will engage in field exercises designed to provide entry-level training for firefighters who have limited or no prior experience in chainsaw operation. These handson experiences will take place in environments that closely resemble fire line scenarios, ensuring practical and relevant skill development. The course is repeatable as necessary for certification purposes.

Pre-Req: FS 61 Basic Firefighter Training (Basic 32) or equivalent
