

DESCRIPTION

This course offers a comprehensive introduction to the operation, maintenance, and effective use of internal combustion engine-powered chainsaws, with a specific focus on their application in tactical wildland firefighting. Participants will engage in field exercises designed to provide entry-level training for firefighters who have limited or no prior experience in chainsaw operation. These hands-on experiences will take place in environments that closely resemble fire line scenarios, ensuring practical and relevant skill development. The course is repeatable as necessary for certification purposes.

Pre-Req: FS 61 Basic Firefighter Training (Basic 32) or equivalent
