SUMMER 2025

JUNE 2ND-JUNE 6TH STOCKMAKING-PHASE I INSTRUCTOR: J. TUCKER

This course is designed for the beginner or the pro in inletting and fitting of accessories to a semiinlet stock blank.

JUNE 2ND-JUNE 13TH MACHINE SHOP FOR GUNSMITHS INSTRUCTOR: B. BAUER

An introductory course designed to help the beginner or the pro in the use of machine shop equipment as it relates to gunsmithing. This course requires a \$19 material fee.

JUNE 9TH-JUNE 13TH STOCKMAKING-PHASE II INSTRUCTOR: J. TUCKER

An introductory course designed to help the beginner or the pro in the shaping and finishing of a semi-inlet stock blank.

JUNE 23RD-JUNE 27TH LAW ENFORCEMENT ARMORER SCHOOL-BASIC

INSTRUCTOR: R. CHAVEZ

An introductory course designed to train law enforcement officers to maintain departmental firearms to factory service levels. Firearms to be covered are Smith & Wesson revolver, Glock, Colt AR-15 and Remington 870 shotgun.

BASIC RIFLE BARRELING INSTRUCTOR: J. FLOYD

This course is desgined to help the beginner or the pro in the use of machine shop equipment to barrel action rifle receivers. This course requires a \$19 material fee

CAUSTIC BLUING INSTRUCTOR: B. MUMMA

A course designed to introduce the student to bluing, commercial black oxide finish on firearms. Preparation of surface finish, care and use of chemicals. Understanding chemical process and control, professional technique and equipment. This course requires a \$19 material fee

JULY 7TH-JULY 11TH BASIC CORRECTIONAL ARMORER INSTRUCTOR: J. FLOYD

An introductory course designed to train correctional officers to maintain their firearms and department firearms to factory service levels.

COLOR CASE HARDENING INSTRUCTOR: B. MUMMA

This course is designed to present the old methods of color case hardening. This requires a \$19 material fee.

JULY 14TH-JULY 18TH GENERAL GUNSMITHING INSTRUCTOR: R. CHAVEZ

A course designed to introduce the student to gunsmithing basics to include, firearms malfunctions, hand tool usage, diagnosis and repair.

ALTERNATIVE METAL FINISHES INSTRUCTOR: B. BAUER

This course is designed to cover alternative metal finishes available to the gunsmith. Topics will include Teflon Coating, Powder Coating, as well as other metal finishes, such as Cerekote.

GTAW (TIG) FOR GUNSMITHS INSTRUCTOR: B. MUMMA

This course is designed to develop the manipulative skills, technical knowledge and applications of the gas tungsten arc welding (GTAW) process as they relate to firearm repair. Students will apply the gas tungsten arc welding process (GTAW) to selected metal types, joint designs and gun parts.

JULY 21ST-JULY 25TH RUST AND NITER BLUING

INSTRUCTOR: B. MUMMA A course designed to introduce the student to rust bluing finish on firearms. Surface preparation and use of chemicals and other appropriate equipment. Understanding control of equipment, chemicals and operating procedures. This course requires a \$19 material fee.

ADVANCED CORRECTIONAL ARMORER INSTRUCTOR: J. FLOYD

An advanced level course designed to train correctional armorers to maintain the department's specialized firearms to factory service levels.

JULY 28TH-AUGUST 1ST

LAW ENFORCEMENT ARMORER SCHOOL-BASIC

INSTRUCTOR: R. CHAVEZ

An introductory course designed to train law enforcement officers to maintain departmental firearms to factory service levels. Firearms to be covered are Smith & Wesson revolver, Glock, Colt AR-15 and Remington 870 shotgun.

BALLISTICS, HANDLOADING, AND TESTING

INSTRUCTOR: J. FLOYD

A course designed to provide the student with detailed knowledge of small arms ammunition. This course requires a \$19 material fee

AUGUST 4TH-AUG 8TH DESIGN AND REPAIR, FULL AUTOS INSTRUCTOR: R. CHAVEZ

An advanced course designed to train law enforcement armorers in the repair and maintenance of fully automatic firearms.
