CSU

CSU Transfer Requirements

- 60 semester units of transferable coursework
- Overall GPA of at least 2.0
- Golden 4, C- or better in: Written Communication, Math, Critical Thinking, Oral Communication
- 34 semester units of general education coursework

Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)

- Guaranteed admission to a CSU
- Transfer as a junior with only 60 more units to complete a bachelor's degree
- Possible GPA bump for impacted campuses & majors
- Ultimately earn two degrees (Associates & Bachelors)
- See which CSU campuses have programs similar to the ADT you want to complete: →

Impacted Majors

Majors that are impacted receive more qualified applicants than spaces available. These may use additional criteria for admission.

Tuition vs Total Cost of Attendance

When we think of tuition, we think of what it costs to go to college, but tuition is only *part* of the financial considerations.

Chico State '23-'24 Cost of Attendance Estimate

Tuition.....	\$5,742
Fees.....	\$2,322
Books/Supplies.....	\$1,052
Food & Housing.....	\$16,020
Transportation.....	\$702
Misc. Personal	\$2,192

Total Cost of Attendance \$28,030

Don't forget housing!

Make sure to apply for on-campus housing *immediately* after submitting your application for admission. Waitlists can be long and housing assignments can be competitive. Check the website of the campus you are interested in to get directed to their housing resources.

Facts & Stats

- CSU's tuition is among the lowest in the country
- More than half of students graduate with no debt
- More than 80% of students at CSU receive some type of financial aid. Apply with FAFSA.

CSU Funding & Financial Aid

Cal Grant (up to \$5,742)

Minimum 2.4 GPA, income-based, term varies by type

Pell Grant (up to \$7,395)

Nearly 50% of students receive a pell grant to help cover tuition, fees, and additional costs. Up to 6 years of pell life if a full-time student.

State University Grant (up to \$2,850)

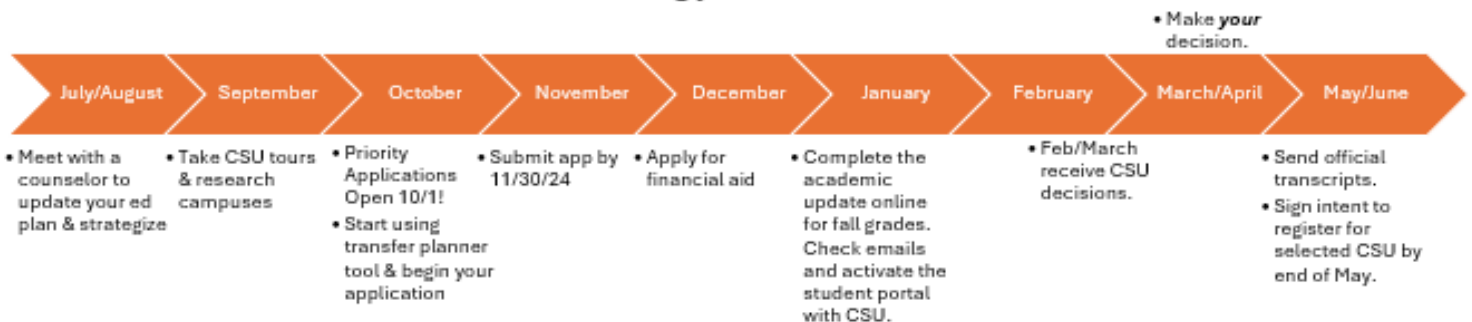
Income-based, may receive for up to 150 units.

Campus Scholarships

Check with the campus to see if they have campus or department scholarships available.

CSU Application Timeline for Fall Term Transfers

For most students, the transfer process will start **a year prior** to the semester you wish to begin attending your CSU.
